1. School admission documents

School admission documents are given to every student who is accepted into Full Cycle Game Academy. These documents are one way to prove your travel purpose when applying for a D-visa. The documents are sent by Full Cycle Game Academy. Please request one from fullcycle@gamecan.eu.

2. Invitation by Full Cycle Game Academy

5. Travel from Tallinn airport to Pärnu

The main bus station's address is Lastekodu 46, 10144 Tallinn. You can reach the location via <u>Bolt taxi service</u>. Just download the app and enter the address of the bus station. From there you can take a bus to Pärnu. Book a bus ticket <u>here</u> from Tallinn Coach Station to Pärnu Coach Station.



6. Registering permanent Estonian address and applying for Estonian ID code

To register your permanent Estonian address and get an Estonian ID code, you need to go to Pärnu's city government (address Suur-Sepa 16, Pärnu) and fill out some forms. After filling the forms, you get an Estonia ID code.

What to bring with you to the city government:

- passport
- signed rent contract
- place of living address

7. Apply for Estonian ID card

To apply for an Estonian ID card, you have to go to Pärnu's Police and Border Guard office (address A. H. Tammsaare pst 61, Pärnu).

What to bring with you to the Police and Border Guard office:

- passport
- Estonian ID code document
- state fee for ID card 30€
